## **Comparing and Scaling Vocabulary**

Percent – Per 100. A way to compare a number to 100.

**Equivalent fraction** – a fraction that have the same value

**Proportion** – An equation that states that two ratios are equal

**Ratio** – a pair of numbers used to compare quantities (ex. For every 28 students, there is 1 teacher. 28:1) (ex. There are 45 A's out of 150 students. 45/150)

**Unit rate** – a rate where two different units are compared and the quantity of one of those units is scaled to one (usually the denominator); example 4 tires per 1 car, 12 cookies per 1 dozen

**Equation** – a number sentence that uses an equal sign (=) to show that the two expressions have the same value.

**Variable** – a letter than stands for a number (or range of numbers)

**Inverse** – a proportion that is reversed (looks like the reciprocal of a fraction)
